Through this service you can access telephone consultation time with a child and adolescent psychiatrist who can provide assistance with any questions or concerns you may have regarding the behavioral health of your pediatric patients. - Patient Age
- Working Diagnosis
- Patient Insurance
- Consultation Question and/or Concern
- Current Medication(s)
- Previous Medication trials
- Significant Patient History (Psychiatric, Developmental, Medical, Social)
- Significant Family Medical/Psychiatric History

Upon receiving a consultation request, our staff will schedule a time for the telephone consultation to take place between the primary care physician and psychiatrist, and at the convenience of the PCP.

This consultation line operates Monday-Friday between 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
