

What is C.A.P.E.S.?

C.A.P.E.S. stands for Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Education and Support. The C.A.P.E.S. Program for Primary Care Physicians (PCPs) is an initiative to better meet the mental health needs of children and adolescents by bringing together the services offered by PCPs, Psychiatrists and mental health providers in our community.

An Established Need

You are probably aware of the fact that there are not enough child and adolescent psychiatrists to see the number of children in the community who need mental health services. A vast majority of children and adolescents seek psychiatric care from their primary care physicians.

Program Overview

The C.A.P.E.S. Program offers PCPs the opportunity to participate in an evidence-based training curriculum and to access consultation services with a child and adolescent psychiatrist. In this way, the quality of care provided to children is improved, and PCPs acquire new skills and more confidence in treating psychiatric issues.

Program Leadership

Dr. Jeffrey M. Daly, Medical Director, Child and Adolescent Outpatient Program, Four Winds Hospital Saratoga, developed this program in 2005. Dr. Daly continues to lead the C.A.P.E.S. Program, which has been enthusiastically received by over 150 physicians in the capital district.

Funding for the Program

The C.A.P.E.S. Program is one of two programs in the State to receive funding from the New York State Office of Mental Health, through its Project T.E.A.C.H. initiative.
